



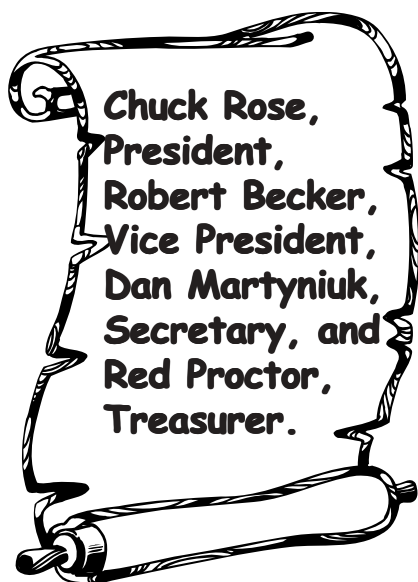

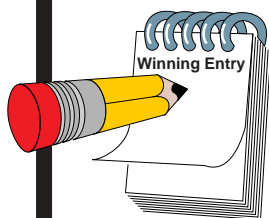
AS P.T. BARNUM ONCE SAID...

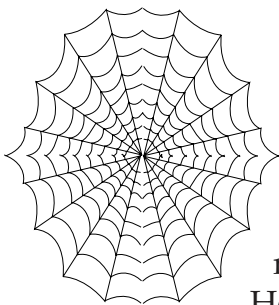

December 9, 2002 —Meeting Minutes

President, Chuck Rose, called the meeting to order at 9:10 a.m.

The following were recorded as being present: Chuck Rose, Red Proctor, Dan Martyniuk, Robert Becker, Mark Morrison and Gail Caveney

Minutes from November 11, 2002: Mark Morrison pointed out that with regard to the verbage on the bumper stickers, he didn't mention anything about including not drinking while driving for this campaign. With this deletion, Mark motioned to accept the minutes and Dan seconded. Minutes approved as corrected.

Treasurer's Report: Balance to date is \$6,443.92 of which \$436 is HOA. There was discussion regarding sending out a reminder letter to those dealerships that are delinquent in their assessments. Gail to follow up. The provisional membership renewals of Red Proctor and Mark Morrison were accepted. Treasurer's Report accepted.

OLD BUSINESS:

Application for Federal Funding: Robert reported that there continues to be no word as yet.

Motorcycle Safety Campaign: Red shared his ideas and samples of bumper stickers. All agreed the smaller size (3x6) was best with 2-color at 48¢ each. All felt it was important to include the HMDA logo and website address. There was discussion on the verbiage. They decided to hold off until a good idea comes up. Robert suggested having a contest with a \$50 gift certificate to Ryan's for the winning slogan for the bumper stickers. Deadline to be set for February 10.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

HOA/Na Ala Hele: Jim Parran is on the mainland so Mark has been unable to get together. Mark wants to find out how available he would be as interim president. The President should be on Oahu to be effective.

Convention: Robert reported that he has an appointment today to see the Hawaii Prince Hotel to check out the facilities. He will report back to the board. He has talked to two entertainers trying to get something different for 2003.

NEW BUSINESS:

Election: The slate of officers is: Chuck Rose as President, Robert Becker as Vice President, Dan Martyniuk as Secretary and Red Proctor as Treasurer. Mark motioned to accept the slate, motion seconded by Robert. All approved.

501c3 Status: In order to retain the 501c3 status, a motion was made by Red to roll over the funds. Seconded by Mark, all approved.

Web Site: Dan mentioned that there are 500 hits per month on the site. He is working on the site to eliminate the number of pages you have to work through.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 9:45 a.m. The next meeting of HMDA will be on Monday, January 13th, 2002 at 8:30 a.m. at the Airport Plaza Hotel Coffee Shop.
