HMDA TO CONTINUE IN 2011

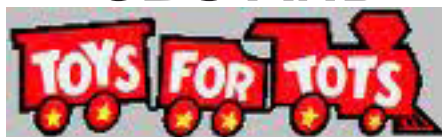

WINTER 2011 State Motorcycle Repair Certification Exam

In cooperation with the University of Hawai'i Community Colleges, the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs, and the Motor Vehicle Repair Industry Board, the State Motorcycle Repair Certification Examination is administered statewide twice a year in the Spring and Fall and will be offered throughout the state during the months of May and December. Applicants must have 2 years of experience and apply with the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs two weeks prior to the test date. Test results will be submitted to applicants and the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs through a letter within 2-3 weeks after completing the exam.

Please call the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs, Motor Vehicle Licensing Office at 586-3000 for an application form. The fee is \$30.00.

Application deadline is two weeks prior to test date. You will receive a confirmation showing the time and place that your test will be given.

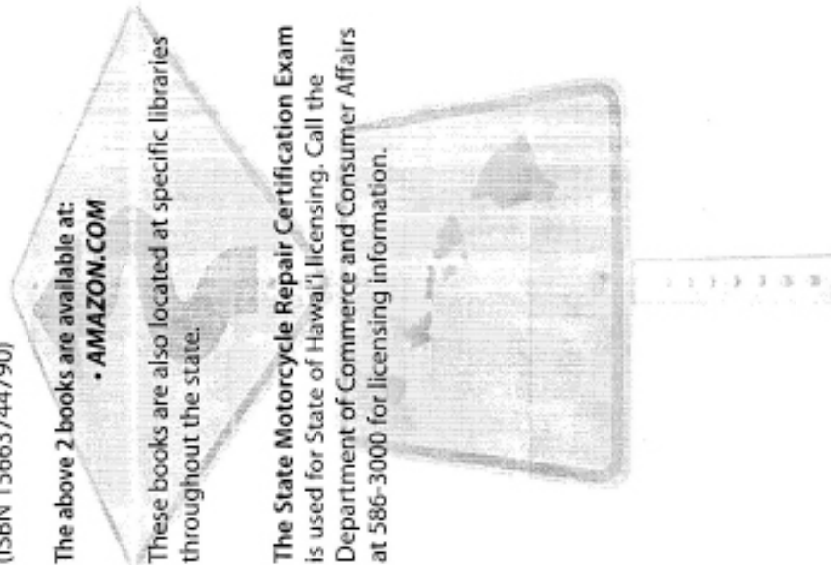
